Alice Gun launches debut album – *Blood & Bone*

Blood & Bone is the debut album from Alice Gun. Recorded at her home in North London and in an isolated farmhouse in the Lake District, this haunting, seductive record is built around a backbone of cello, guitars and piano, all played by Alice and fleshed out with accordions, e-bows, drums, double bass and auto-harp played by her and the band: multi-instrumentalists Al Mobbs and Sam Campari, and drummer Robbie Jarvis.

Alice Gun also plays cello for blues man Mr David Viner in a long-running collaboration which has included recording with Ed Harcourt and supporting the White Stripes on their last European tour. She also does house music vocals for the money.
